


Congratulations to the class of 2015 – 2016 with their excellent results.

The cohort of 2014 – 2016 has performed very well with 98% of the students receiving their ICE (International Certificate of Education) diploma. Nine students have received their diploma with Distinction (averaging more than 5 A's), 34 students a Merit, and 6 students received a clear Pass.

A staggering 478 individual exams were administered to candidates from our school, with 83% of the students receiving an A* – C grade.

Special congratulations go to the students who have worked hard and earned their diploma with a Distinction.
